CALIFORNIA NATIVES FOR GRASSLANDS

Inland grasslands are a shrubless vegetative cover that was historically dominated by perennial bunchgrasses. Intermingled among the grasses were numerous species of bulbs, annual wildflowers and perennial forbs (green leafy plants). Most plant growth occurs rapidly during the rainy season, dying off as the dry season approaches. Soils are often clay with dormant grasses providing some soil cover during the summer.

Coastal grasslands have a much greater component of perennial forbs growing among the bunchgrasses, as well as scattered shrubs and drifts of bracken ferns. The foggy conditions provide year-round moisture. Open grasslands are lovely but hard to maintain as unwanted weeds and annual grasses like to move in.
