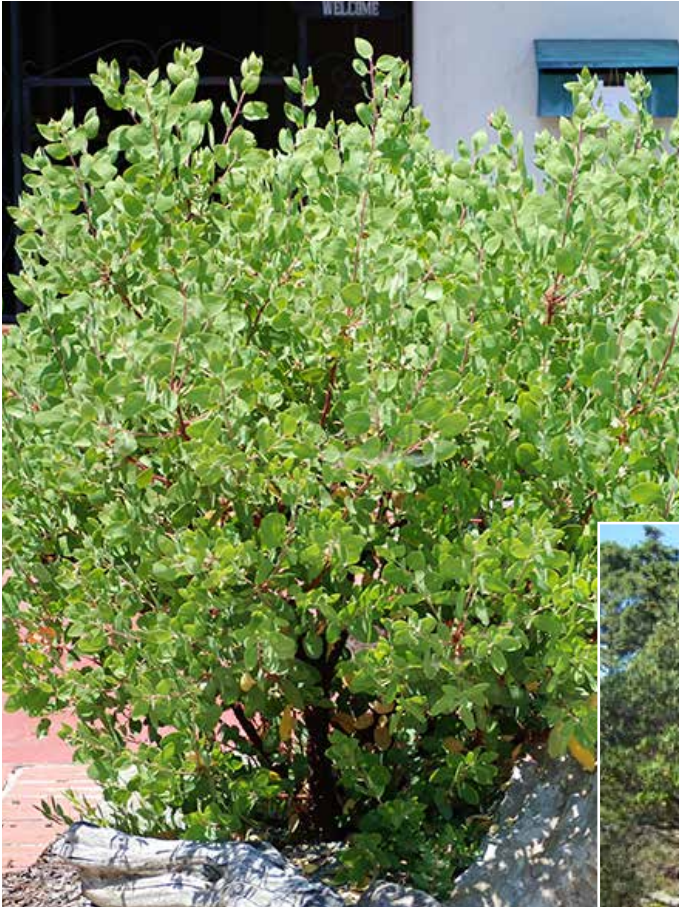


# 'Dr. Hurd' Manzanita

## traits

- Evergreen shrub, upright form
- Generally 10–15 ft tall by 8–10 ft wide
- Full sun, light shade
- Can handle some summer water or can be summer dry
- Glossy, light-green rounded leaves and mahogany bark
- Showy clusters of pink or white flowers in late winter
- Produces clusters of red-tinged berries in fall
- Fast grower and very reliable
- Grows well in clay soil and will tolerate sandy soil
- Plant as a specimen plant or in a row for screening
- Deer resistant
