traits

- Evergreen shrub
- 3–4 ft tall by 4–6 ft wide mound
- Needs full sun
- Can survive on very little irrigation
- More attractive if given an occasional deep watering
- Fast growing and highly aromatic
- Flowers in spring/summer with hundreds of violet-blue flowers
- Plant in well-drained flats, bluffs or on gentle slopes
- Great plant to attract butterflies and hummingbirds
- Deer resistant
- Don't plant the straight species (*Salvia clevelandii*), it won't survive garden conditions
